## Park Rules for Progress Days

1. There will be no parking of any vehicle within the grounds of Hansen Park.  
(The popcorn wagon etc. are exceptions.)
2. All garbage must be moved to the dumpster provided along the south side of the park or in cans placed along the guardrail on north side of grounds. These will be emptied by 6:00 a.m. Sunday morning.
3. In the event of bad weather and wet grounds, Bristol Public Works employees will supervise the set up of rides and booths and their removal in order to prevent damage to the park.
4. On Saturday and Sunday set up traffic will be allowed on the ground between the hours of 8:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. ONLY.
5. Parking will not be allowed the street north of the park. Any vehicle parked there will be towed at owners expense.
6. Electric will be provided to those who need it, please let us know in advance.
7. If you are in violation of these rules and cause damage to the park grounds you will be responsible for any cost that the Village of Bristol incurs in returning the park in its previous condition. Bills will be issued to those offenders.
